








The ineffable is a fundamental aspect of ordinary life, a voice that exists beyond language. In a world often perceived as entirely written and spoken, I seek to create a more nuanced correspondence between things and words.

My work explores a poetic language that proposes new narratives and reimagines our understanding of the everyday. I am particularly interested in the exploration of space—both as a material and as an element of the sculptural question. By rearranging and modifying visual elements, I aim to imbue meaning into what is often dismissed as insignificant, challenging our perception of the ordinary and the construction of normativity. Through my practice, I create sculptural situations that act as gaps or spaces of emptiness—moments where it is uncertain if an action has occurred or is even meant to occur. These works invite contemplation and suggest a transcendece of collective understanding, uncovering the poetic complexity rooted in the mysteries of life.
